When you are buying school uniform for September please remember the following:

- Red school sweatshirt or cardigan for all children up to Year 5
- Black sweatshirt for Year 6
- Red or white plain t-shirt, polo shirt, blouse or shirt
- Grey or black skirts or trousers. No jeans.
- Red striped or check dresses
- Hijabs should be in school colours (red, white or black)
- School shoes should be **black or 'mostly black'** (not trainers).

School PE kits:

- Pair of dark shorts, or leggings
- A plain white T-shirt or a red Winton T-shirt
- A pair of trainers or plimsolls.
- Tracksuits are needed for games sessions outside in colder months

Children will not be able to take part in PE lessons if they do not have the correct kit. If your child has swimming sessions they will need a swimming costume, swimming caps or trunks and a towel.

Please send children to school in sensible footwear that is comfortable and that they can run about in.

School breaks up for Easter break on Friday 3rd April at 2pm.


SUMMER TERM

School breaks up for half term on Friday 22nd May


School starts back on Monday 1st June.
