


Dear Winton Families,



AR Makr, APP is a creative toolbox for augmented reality. You can create your own AR animations and use them on any surface rather than using a trigger like with other AR apps. So kids can create worlds with characters in them and then see them come to life on any flat surface. Really good for storytelling.
