


**Punctuality matters!**

Being frequently late for school adds up to lost learning:

- Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year.
- Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year.
- Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year.

19 days lost a year through being late means 90% attendance.

**missed minutes = missed learning  
= missed opportunities!**

being in school at least  
96% of the time**

- 365 days in the calendar year

**90-95% = less chance of success**

**96% and above = best chance of success**

School breaks up for half term on Friday 22nd May


