We aim to continue with this initiative and have more outdoor lessons, in order to allow our students to benefit from these amazing green spaces!



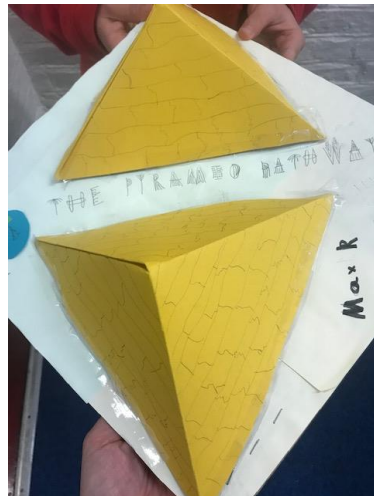
Year 5 at Samsung X


